Training sessions are tailored for different working surroundings, such as enclosed stores or outdoors on a construction site. Course content includes safety protocol and daily inspection procedures. Trainees learn how to maneuver within a populated work surroundings.

A lift truck could be a dangerous machine if used by an unqualified individual. Potential operator have to go through forklift training by a certified instructor before they begin utilizing a forklift in order to reduce the risks for workplace accidents. All parts of forklift use are covered in training programs. The abilities and limits of the equipment are included, together with pre-operation checks, fundamental operating measures and methods of warning other personnel that a forklift is in the work site.

Lessons comprise the placement of the trailer tires and chock blocks, the arrangement of pallets to distribute the load right, and inspections required before driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses also consist of Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Though not related directly to the utilization of a lift truck, MSDS training is essential if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and correct methods of dealing with spills.
